BACKGROUND

On July 18, 2022, the Department issued <u>Memorandum #2022-031 regarding a Secondary</u> Employment Pay Rate Change (link).

ANALYSIS

Upon further analysis, the secondary employment pay rate will not change effective January 1, 2023.

Per Duty Manual section C 1506, the Chief of Police has the sole authority to set the pay scale for uniformed (including any modified uniformed assignments) secondary employment assignments. Department members will continue to be paid at the following rates:

- Officer \$70 per hour (minimum of 3 hours or \$210 per assignment)
- Sergeant \$80 per hour (minimum of 3 hours or \$240 per assignment)
- Lieutenant \$92 per hours (minimum of 3 hours or \$276 per assignment)

CONCLUSION

The secondary employment pay rate will remain the same until further notice.
