BACKGROUND

A review of the Duty Manual discovered revisions were necessary to bring it into alignment with best practices.

ANALYSIS

The Duty Manual has been revised to reflect changes described below. Additions are shown in *italics and underlined*. Deletions are shown in ~~strike-through~~ form.

L 2004 USE OF EMERGENCY LIGHTS AND SIREN:

Revised 10-14-22

When a vehicle is being operated in an emergency manner, the ~~e~~Department member driving will *continuously* use the emergency lights and siren. Neither the siren nor the emergency lights alone are sufficient; both must be used for the response to be considered an emergency.

ORDER

Effective immediately, all Department personnel shall adhere to the above Duty Manual section.
