On January 1, 2023, the Judicial Council of California adopted a revised Emergency Protective Order (EPO) Form EPO-001. The language of the form has been updated to provide clear instructions on prohibited conduct of a restrained party. The form is to be used to protect persons who fear the immediate danger or threat of domestic violence, including child abuse, child abduction, elder abuse, dependent adult abuse, or stalking.

The following changes were made to the new revised form:

- A gender classification of "X" was added to section 2.
- The following possible violations were added to section 3(a):
 - Impersonate
 - Annoy by phone or other electronic means (including repeatedly contact)
 - Disturb the peace of (including coercive control)
- Language in section 11 was changed to: "The person in 1 and 2 live together. The person in 1 asks that the person in 2 immediately move out from the address in item 3c.
- Language in section 13 was changed to: "I personally delivered (served) copies of this Order to the person *named in 2 on (date)*:______ at (time): _____"

All Department members should discard any previous versions of the EPO Form EPO-001 and replace them with the new version of EPO Form EPO-001(Rev. January 1, 2023). The revised EPO Form EPO-001 is available at Central Supply.
